Municipal Waste & Recycling will have their loads rejected if they have plastic bags in any of the Blue Bins. The **ONLY** exception is for shredded paper.

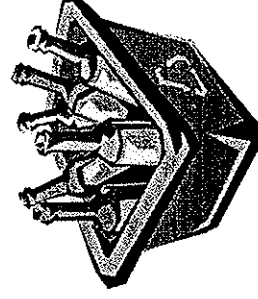
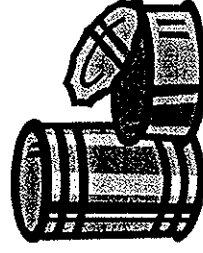
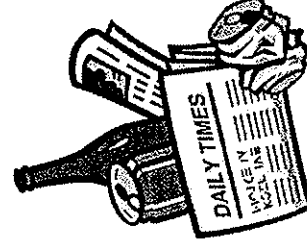
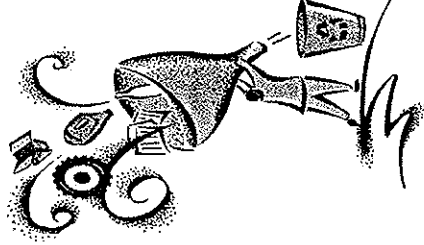


The **BLUE BINS**

ALUMINUM & CO-MINGLE
(**PLASTICS #1 - #6**)

Please read the signs on front of the bins.
We can recycle more items now... DQ shake containers, Styrofoam take out containers & meat trays, plastic chairs, pots & trays (or return them to the nursery), veggie trays, some tops of coffee jars, fruit containers & trays & much, much more.
Look for the sample board of things to recycle.

Please ask an Attendant or pick up information brochures in the Share Shed for more in-depth information on acceptable items.
IF YOU NEED ANY HELP PUTTING GARBAGE OR RECYCLABLES WHERE THEY BELONG PLEASE ASK THE ATTENDANT FOR ASSISTANCE. THEY ARE THERE TO HELP YOU!



DID YOU KNOW... that some plastics will take up to 1000 years to biodegrade!!

DID YOU KNOW... that the average time for **ONE** water bottle to completely degrade is **450 years!!!**

DID YOU KNOW... the main ingredient in plastic is **CRUDE OIL!**

DID YOU KNOW... that you need a sticker for your windshield to prove you are from either Township?

FLATTEN ALL CARDBOARD

STYROFOAM is still being collected in the silver shipping container. **PLEASE LOOK FOR THE RECYCLING LABEL. NOT ALL STYROFOAM IS ACCEPTED.**

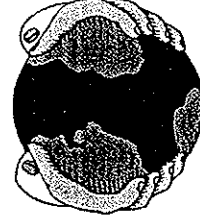
Please be considerate & don't include other garbage.

NO COLOURED! NO CONSTRUCTION ITEMS!

NO PEANUTS! NO MEAT TRAYS! NO DIRTY PIECES!

Ruth Wigmore is still **VOLUNTEERING** to collect Styrofoam, at the Landfill & take it to the Sault. It takes time enough to load without having to sift through garbage & unacceptable Styrofoam. Please **LOOK** for the recycle symbols!



DID YOU KNOW... water bottles can be recycled into polar fleece, rope, brushes, car bumpers, furniture!!!

COMPOSTER PASSWORD
composting = rich soil.

DID YOU KNOW... Johnson & Tarbutt Landfill, along with the Recycling Depots at 17 East Trading Post & the Echo Bay Environmental Center recycled... 73 tonnes of cardboard - 55 tonnes of paper, 47 tonnes of co-mingle & 16 tonnes of glass = 191 tonnes of recyclables kept out of our Landfills.

Before arriving at the Landfill please have your load separated

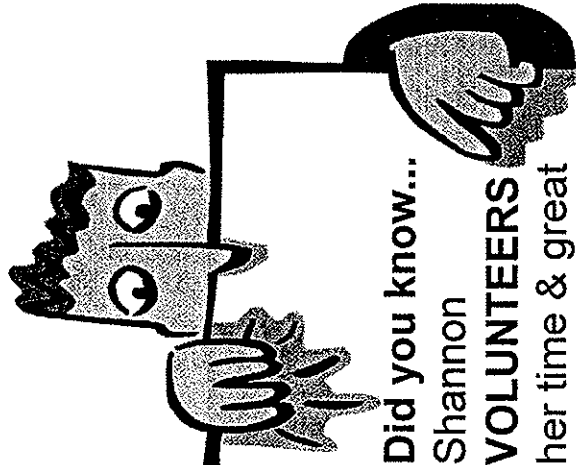

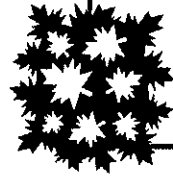
