## LANDFILL CHANGES Starting the week of Wednesday, April 9.

New bins are now in place for household waste. Rather than filling the bunker, household waste will be deposited into the square bins backing onto the building. Non-household waste such as construction materials, furniture, and large items that are not recyclable will be placed in the large bin alongside the raised ramp for scrap metal. The filled containers will be shipped away from the site in an effort to extend the life of the landfill and save it from filling up.

the site. These stickers
indicate that you have landfill
privileges. If you have not
received a sticker, please call
your local township office to
have one sent to you.

## THE LOADING RAMP FOR SCRAP METAL AND LARGE, NON HOUSEHOLD ITEMS WILL BE

**EXTENDED** to allow more room to back up and turn around. Until this work can be done in the spring, please bear with us.

Your patience is greatly appreciated.

Black Bags are not permitted for any use.

Please use clear or white bags for recycling.

All plastic and metal recycling should be bagged.
