Desbarats Community Days celebrations on July 8 and 9th.

This year's Community Days celebrations saw a few exciting changes including a new kick-off event on Friday evening (July 8th). Many community members gathered under the Pavilion at the Johnson Township Community Centre on Friday evening to enjoy bonfires, s'mores, and a fireworks show. Saturday, July 9th's beautiful weather prompted community members to come out to enjoy the classic Community Days parade. Prizes of over \$800 from the Erling Lagerholm Fund were awarded to winning floats in a variety of categories. After the parade, celebrations on the Arena floor included games such as Fish Pod, Axe Throw, Plinko, Hockey Shuffle, and more! JULY 20, 2022

Discussions continue with Tarbutt Township on how to best proceed regarding the operational plans of the Joint Landfill Site. Tarbutt Township is currently overseeing the management of the Joint Landfill Site, under a one year trial period agreement.

Preliminary information and costs to replace the Cora Road bridge which washed out many years ago has begun and will be reported on in upcoming council meets.



Community Centre Updates

The construction at the Johnson Township Community Centre is going well and is currently within budget replacement of the rubber mat flooring on the first floor of the Arena is now completed. Concerns regarding the building's water pressure have been addressed and users should see an increase in pressure this season. Drainage work has been completed along the North and West wall of the Community Centre with the North wall finally being enclosed. Issues with the North wall are thought to have been a result of a failure of the original drainage system which has now been rectified. The new exterior siding for the upper section of the Community Centre is expected to arrive and be installed later

As construction inside and outside the Community Centre continues, we will do our best to avoid any interruptions in services and bookings. We appreciate your patience and understanding during this time and can't wait to unveil the fina results!

Notes from the Fire Chief

If you haven't already, now is the time to apply for your burning permit. There is <u>no cost</u> to acquire your permit and it can be done easily online at www.johnsontownship.ca/services/fire-department or in person at the Township Municipal Office.

CAUTION

A friendly reminder that burning plastics and rubber tires can release toxic chemicals and greenhouse gases into the air which affects the surrounding community and all people/creatures who live there. Please be respectful of our clean air.

Fire Permit Conditions

- the permit holder must have the permit at the burn site
- burning may only take place two hours before sunset, during the night, and 2 hours after sunrise
- the permit holder must not leave the burn site until the fire is completely extinguished
- the permit holder assumes full responsibility (including criminal/financial) if the fire causes damage
- failure to comply can result in your permit being revoked
