The Public Works Garage

With snow building up, be cautious while driving on our roads. Keep an eye out for the Public Works Crew as they work to keep the roadways clear. Watch for our crew when going around corners and blind spots and be mindful of speed with the ice and snow on the roads. Remember to respect the space behind our plow trucks and avoid passing. During these winter months, parking is not allowed on Hamlet streets or roads.

Do Not Push Snow Across The Streets and Roads!

ATTENTION: Please keep your water meter AND 911 signs clear of debris and snow. This includes keeping steps and laneways clear of snow and ice for ease of access to Municipal Staff reading the meters monthly.

Notes from the Fire Chief

Never run portable generators inside. Always run outdoors, away from windows and a safe distance away from any structures.

Always use heavier gauge extension cords rated for higher amps than what will be drawn by the appliances you are running.

Just like generators, never run any gas powered equipment such as snow blowers or chainsaws indoors.

Never refuel any gas powered equipment inside. Always move the equipment outside into fresh air and away from any structures. If a spill occurs, wait a few minutes to allow the gas spill to evaporate before starting the engine.

If you have a garage, ensure it has a CO detector installed to notify you of any Carbon Monoxide built up.

Always store gasoline in approved, well sealed containers. Do Not store near any ignition sources such as pilot lights, electric heaters or furnaces. Always store gas containers in a garage or shed, never in your house.

Tax bills have been mailed out; the first payment is due on February 28th 2025, and the second payment is due on April 30th 2025. If you have not received your bill in the mail, please reach out to the Municipal office at 705-782-6601.
