FROM THE COUNCIL CHAMBERS

March 19 2025

Staff are making plans for the 2025 budget. This means getting paperwork ready for the 2024 audit and working on departmental budgets. The first budget meeting of 2025 will take place on April 23, 2025. Council and staff will be going over the overall budget and allocating time to answer any questions about the budget needs of the community.

Council supported various motions this month including:

- Sarnia City Council's resolution to stop the 20% increase to the Carbon Tax, scheduled to start April 1, 2025.
- Durham Region Council's ban of the Nazi Swastika in Canada.
- Township of Brudenell, Lyndoch and Raglan Council's & Toronto Council's resolution that Toronto is a Paid-Plasma-Free Zone.
- Township of Uxbridge General Purpose and Administration Committee's Buy Canadian policy in regard to municipal procurement.

Council received the PUC Desbarats Drinking Water System Annual & Summary Reports for 2024. PUC will be providing a full presentation at next month's meeting.
